## 2. Missional Jesus

**Key Point:** God is a missionally minded God & Jesus the greatest missionary ever to live

Connect Group Questions

This series is designed to get us thinking about what it means to be “on mission” with God.

If our motivation is a passion for God’s glory, how do we translate that to our everyday life? It’s easy to sit and talk about it, but what does living for God’s glory actually look like?

Jesus was the greatest missionally motivated person ever to live. We can begin to answer these questions by looking at his life and example.

1. Begin by recalling what you remember from the sermon? Key words, ideas, thoughts, pictures etc.
2. Luke 13:24-27 seems to suggest that some people who thought they knew Jesus will not make it to heaven. Is this harsh? Why would some make it while others wouldn’t?
3. John 1:1-14 – Jesus is God and then chose to become a human. How difficult do you think this would have been?
4. Philippians 2:5-11 – If Jesus was **fully** a human on earth how did he manage to remain sinless?
5. Luke 4:16-21 – how would you react if someone came to Russell Park Baptist Church and claimed to fulfil this scripture from Isaiah?
6. In this passage he sets out his mission. What was it? Did he fulfil it? What things did Jesus do while on earth? What were his priorities?
7. Luke 6:27-32 & 1 Peter 2:15-17 - Jesus was a revolutionary and the most extraordinary man to ever live. He changed the whole world while remaining a pacifist. How?
8. Can you remember what the opposite of love is? How can we exercise our love muscle?
9. Everything that Jesus did we also can do. What 2 relationships needed to be right in order for this to happen?
10. Pray as a group using the chorus from “Shine” below to inspire you.

*Shine:*
